It is vitally important that as many people as possible apply for these positions so as to give us the best cross section of our members , so if you are unsure of whether you are qualified for this but are 4 years around and would be up to this most important piece of service, then please just apply anyway .

The order of events are :

1. Applications are made on the forms herein and returned via email to by **13th July 2009 by email to: shorkulak@btinternet.com**

2. The Liaison Committee to check the forms are correct and you will then be invited to attend the Assembly on 1st August 2009 in Chalk Farm.

3. You will be invited to give a simple presentation of yourself along the current lines of applying for any committee position at group , district or area.

4. There will be a vote and the Directors will be appointed there and then.

5. Thereafter the Directors will meet on a regular basis, probably monthly to action and settle the business of the fellowship .

This will be a 2 year commitment.
